- Work independently and with colleagues to teach & maintain a program of study that meets all requirements of Chapter 74 regulations including but not limited to: Establishing and meeting business objectives for an ongoing business enterprise in the Carpentry program; Develop and maintain a network of business professionals in the Carpentry Industry as per the Program Advisory Committee requirements; Execute a formal Program Advisory Committee meeting a minimum of twice annually.
- Maintain all Carpentry equipment in good working order.
- Teach OSHA 10-hour course, teach CADD and/or Blueprint reading/drawing for Carpentry
- Modify instruction to help meet the needs of all students enrolled in Carpentry.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A MA DESE License as a Chapter 74 Instructor in Carpentry. If not licensed, applicants must have:
 - High school diploma or equivalent
 - Five (5) years (within the last seven (7) years) full-time employment experience directly related to Carpentry.
 - An associate's degree (in related field) may substitute for one of the five years of required work experience / A bachelor's degree (in related field) may substitute for two of the five years.
- A minimum of three (3) years successful teaching experience in Carpentry preferred, not required.
- OSHA 10 Safety Certification preferred.
- Knowledge of the MA Vocational Technical Curriculum Frameworks for Carpentry
